COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Weed Control: No Report

Dam: Tim A. met with Theresa Cremonete, Emergency Plan is to call 911. Tim A. is the primary emergency contact. Tim A and Tim H will set a date to cut down saplings around dam.

Water quality: Best 3 readings: Public Landing @ 7'4", 3 sites (4, 5 and 10) @ 6'10", Turner's house (3) @ 6'8"

Water at 5 sites was semi-clear. At 3 sites was slightly murky. Another 3 sites water was murky. One site (#8) was clear. Lots of surface algae at #8 & #11. And near shore algae from bridge to # 9. Wind was too strong to determine elsewhere (on the big part of the lake).

Discussed John B's findings: 57% of homes with Timberchar, anywhere from 1-5 bags, Hunter Bay has 3.45 bags per acre, main lake has only 1.04 bags per acre of water. With drain filter bags: 1.28 bags per acre. Question: Does station 2 show any improvement in nutrient contamination from drains? North of bridge is less than 1 bag per acre. Can we use Secchi disk readings for deciding when to delay weed kill? Post cards need to be distributed and have face to face conversations to influence installation. Discussed ice off influence on early first weed kill. Total rain per month does not appear to have a direct influence on Secchi disk readings.
