COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Weed Control: No activity. Waiting for application to administer chemical treatments to be approved by the State.

Dam: No activity. Request was made to do yearly clearings at this phase two section of the dam vs every two years. D. Mancini concerned about leaves, grass trimmings, etc. being discarded by Oak Knoll and/or Causeway residents. OWL letter to be sent to residents of these streets to cease this practice. A new company is needed to keep the pathway of the dam cleared. Copies are needed for Emergency Action Plan from Tim A.

Water quality: Lorrie gave update from meeting with Brian Vick, Drain commission and township. Working to find a solution to catch garbage coming out of grand river drain. Need to reach out to David Jude for more readings throughout the year to submit to drain commission. Attendance needed for township meetings January 26th and February 9th. Stu said that nano-bubblers may not be something to decide/install until 2027. Discussed The Cove project and next steps. Would like to hire an environmental attorney to write a letter to the township. John is meeting with township trustees to discuss water findings and presentation.

Communication Committee: Mail poet is working well as new mail platform. Develop letter writing campaign to support OWL's position to township trustees and planning commission by those in our community who use the lake, not just residents.

Old business: Cheryl requested to reinstate the 501c3 process (allowing riparians & others to tax deduct contributions). Cheryl discussed lake draw down in fall/winter of 26. Discussion about lowering the lake water level in the fall was brief, discuss again in future meetings.

New Business: Anita to revise date to May 20 for yearly OWL meeting at the township.

Next regular meeting will be TBD in February 11, 2026, at 7:30pm via Zoom.
